






Ohio Independent Degrees Are More Cost Effective


Better Educated Means Less Likely To Be Unemployed

Minority Enrollment at Ohio Independents Increases Over a Decade



Independent Colleges Share Commitment To Serving Low-Income Students


Percentage of undergraduate students awarded Pell Grants at Ohio institutions


Average Ohio student loan default rate by institution type
